



The Pink PussyHat Project

In Anticipation of the
Women's March January 21st, 2017
Washington D.C. • Austin • Portland

Knitted hat on circular needles
For worsted weight yarn

Cast on 80 stitches

Using US size 7-9, 16" circular needle

Use your best judgment on needle size – I knit tightly so I used a size 9

For a good, gap free connection cast on 81 stitches and move the last stitch you cast on (on the needle in your right hand) over next to the first stitch you cast on (on the needle in your left hand) Place a stitch maker on the right needle and then knit the first two stitches together. You now have 80 stitches. Knit another stitch for your first K2.

Knit 2, Purl 2 all the way around for the first row – continue your ribbing for about an inch (or, as the Yarn Harlot says, until you're tired of ribbing)

When you are finished with ribbing change to stockinette (knit all stitches) until the hat measures 8.5 or 9 inches.

(Go crazy. Add cables. Add stripes or whatever!)

When hat is complete cast off stitches, leaving a long tail.

Turn wrong side out and using the tail seam the top of the hat in your preferred manner: using a crochet hook and single crochet stitches, or a tapestry needle and any manner of seaming.
